One of the highlights of this year's London Design Festival is Tania Clarke Hall's stylish range of contemporary leather jewellery. This is the first year that Tania will be exhibiting her eye-catching pieces at Origin - the London Crafts Fair, which takes place from 23 to 29 September.

Tania's jewellery is bold, confident, versatile and highly wearable. She has a love of experimentation both in terms of colours and the techniques that she uses, which maximise the potential of leather. Cutting, tearing, slashing and colouring the leather are all processes that she employs to create extraordinary collections of necklaces, bracelets and earrings. Colour is central to the work and Tania highlights the edges of leather with flashes of golds, deep reds and cobalt blues creating instant impact and effect.

Her work has already received critical acclaim and has been sold at the V&A, Tate Modern and Tate Britain. Earlier this year she was selected by Southbank Centre to design a collection for them.
